On Sunday the 18th, he will be visiting with our High Schoolers to share his message of love, self-care, and social responsibility.

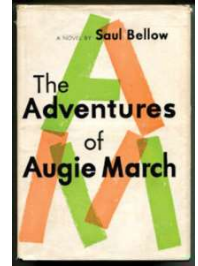
